Project Stabilization Agreements, or Project Labor Agreements, are tools used by countless public and private developers throughout the state to ensure quality construction projects in which all contractors can submit bids.

These agreements ensure that projects are completed on time, on budget and with clear guidelines for the labor force. They are **the only way to legally require contractors to provide healthcare** for workers and **to make certain that the local workforce** is used to build our local schools.
