> When I put those kids down at night, I feel a sense of pride because I know I can do right by them.  
> To many of my old friends from Grant H.S. have had a tough time after H.S.  
> Each and everyone of them deserves the kind of opportunity that I've had.  
> I want to thank the Kings, the Mayor and my Union for what this agreement means to young men and women from communities like mine. It means hope. It

means picking up a hammer instead of a gun or pipe. It means you can feel like the man or woman who stands tall and takes care of business.  
> Ten years from now when I take my kids to a King game they are going to know their Dad helped build the Arena. That's something special I look forward to.
