Hi Ron: Understood you came by, and I missed you. The project is for the Water Resources Agency, as you know, a separate agency from the County.

Here is the applicable section of our proposed legislation:

(b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Agency may award a design-build contract for the combined design and construction of the Project. The Agency shall establish a procedure for the selection of the design-build entity for the Project that, at a minimum, shall include the following:

(A) The award of the contract shall be based upon a written proposal that is determined to be the most advantageous to the Agency; and

(B) The Agency or design-build entity enters into a collective bargaining agreement that binds all of the contractors performing work on the Project.

(c) The Agency may utilize a design-build contract solely for the Project and for no other purpose.

SEC. 3.

Pleased to look at any other recommendation you all have.
